Serves women leaving an abusive relationship, with or without children. Provides food and emergency clothing.

### **Urban Manor Housing**

Cost: 1) If they have income - \$400/month room & board  
2) If no income – then no cost

Assists transient and hard-to-house men, ages 30 and up, with basic necessities, food, shelter, and clothing. 10% turnover, but often full; some residents have been there 20 years.

### **WIN House (Edmonton Women's Shelter)**

Hours: Open 24 hours

Provides temporary accommodation for women and children who are abused. Provides food and emergency clothing. WIN House III also provides a culturally sensitive shelter for immigrant women.

### **WEAC (Women's Emergency Accommodation Centre)**

Hours: Open 24 hours

Provides food, shelter, counselling, support, respite and referrals for women and transgendered individuals with multiple presenting problems - needing to stabilize before moving on to other programs or life situations.

### **YESS (Youth Emergency Shelter Society)**

Serves homeless youth under the age of 18. Provides short term residential care for homeless youth including food, clothing, etc.

### **YMCA Transitional Housing**

Cost: Single women - \$40/day or \$145/week  
Couple - \$63/day or \$190/week  
Men's dorm (3 share) - \$25/day  
Men's single - \$43/day or \$155/week

Provides temporary shelter to families, couples and/or individuals 24 hours a day 7 days a week. Applicants must have government-issued I.D. and must make \$10 keydeposit (*returned when they leave*). Almost always full: best luck to call at 11:00 am (*checkout time*).
